NO EXCEPTIONS

If there are any openings after sign-up night, we will accept paid reservations until we reach 250.

Sign-up Priority:

- <u>2018 SWAMP FOX PACK</u>: Packs that attended in 2018 will be next for their same weekend with a possible adjusted number of attendees in 2019. If space allows you may be able to move to another weekend.
 - o Once the weekend is full, it will be closed to additional participants based on capacity.
- NEW PACKS IN 2019: After all returning Packs are done, we will open the available spaces to NEW Packs.
 - New Packs once registered/paid will receive the same weekend the following year (2020).
- ROSTERS: To reserve camping spots, only this official completed roster will be accepted.
- SHIRT SIZES: Due by August 9, 2019, otherwise youth receive an ADULT SMALL, adults receive an ADULT XL
- ACTIVITY SESSIONS: As a PACK you will be able to plan an activity.
 - <u>Examples of activities</u>: Field games, first aid, knot tying, compass, leather, nature, frisbee golf, tire bowling and lots more.
- BSA HEALTH FORM: Every camper (INCLUDING parents and siblings) must have a Form A/B at camp.



Refund Policy:

The \$15 deposit is TRANSFERABLE but NON-REFUNDABLE.

- Refunds will only be considered before June 4, 2019 for extenuating circumstances
 - (Documented injury/illness, death in the family, etc.).
- After June 4, 2019, the maximum refund will be 50%.
- Within 4 weeks, only extreme cases will be considered for a partial refund.
- All refund requests must be in writing (PAC Refund Form).
