

## Vehicles in Camp:

All units must check in with the Camp Master or Camp Ranger before going to cabin or campsite. The following number of vehicles will be allowed to drive to their respective cabin or campsite where they are to park at designated spots until they leave camp. This means you drive up to your site and park the vehicle until Sunday. Do not make multiple trips. One trip up on arrival, one trip down when leaving. If the vehicles leave camp before checking out they are to be parked in the camp parking lot until Sunday checkout.

Rotary cabin: 4 vehicles

Kiwanis cabin: 2 vehicles

OA cabin: 2 vehicles

Campsites: 2 vehicles

If unsure where to park, ask the Camp Master or Camp Ranger. Please stay off the grass. Failure to abide by these rules could result in forfeiture of all or part of your deposit. A minimum of \$25 per violation could be forfeited from your deposit of the Driving Policy. This policy is necessary for the safety of everyone in camp, to reduce wear on the camp property, and to maintain a Scouting environment. Due to camp road conditions may be limited to restricted areas deemed by Camp Ranger through the Camp Masters.

*Remember, these rules are for Scout and Scouter safety – a safe outing is always a successful outing.*
